:: NOTICE ::

As per the provision of University ordinance clause 11.6(d)-II a student is required to clear 50 percent credits of Ist & IInd year. If any student fails to obtain 50 percent credits he will fall under year back category. In order to facilitate students to clear the backlog, back paper examinations were conducted for the students. Students who were debarred in Ist, IInd & IIIrd semesters due to the shortage of attendance special classes were arranged for such students. Students who attained 70 percent attendance in debarred classes were allowed to appear in back paper examinations.

After the declaration of back paper examination results, it was noticed that some of the students did not succeed in clearing 50 percent of credits. As per the provisions of the ordinance such students fall under year back category. **The students who were not debarred will have to study on their own & will register themselves for back paper examinations whenever notified. The back paper examinations for such students will be conducted along-with regular examinations.**

If a student is debarred in subjects of 3rd & 4th semester he/she will be required to take re-admission in third semester and attend all the classes and then appear in the exams.
